INGREDIENTS:

1pkg. (3oz) lime Jello 16 large marshmallows 8oz cream cheese, softened 20oz can crushed pineapple with juice

Carol's Lime Jello Salad

1 Tb mayonnaise

1 Tb evaporated milk

2-3 bananas, diced 1/2 cup chopped nuts (optional) 1/2 cup shredded coconut (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Dissolve lime Jello, % cup of hot water, and 16 large marshmallows over heat. Remove from heat once dissolved.
- In a large bowl, mix cream cheese, crushed pineapple with juice, mayonnaise, evaporated milk, bananas, chopped nuts, and shredded coconut.
- Add lime Jello mixture to pineapple mixture. Mix well with mixer and chill until firm.

Note: You can substitute strawberry Jello instead of lime Jello & diced strawberries instead of diced bananas.
